Students will have to study English Language at First and Second Semester, Environmental studies at Third and Forth Semester and Computer Application at Fifth and Sixth Semester as compulsory subject.

Commerce

University has limited seats(Total 60) available for the students of B.Com

2. Master of Commerce (M.Com)

University has limited seats(Total 30) available for the students of M.Com

Management

1. Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.)

University has limited seats(Total 60) available for the students of B.B.A

FACULTY OF SCIENCES

Admission would be given for the following courses:-

1. Bachelor of Computer Application (B.C.A.)

University has limited seats(Total 60) available for the students of B.C.A.

2. Bachelor of Science (Hons.) B.Sc.

Subject Combinations for B.Sc. (Hons.):

Chemistry is compulsory for all & the students may choose any two subjects out of the following subjects .:

1. Environmental Science
2. Botany
3. Zoology
4. Biotechnology
5. Anthropology

The students will have to study English Language in first and second semester, Environmental studies in third and fourth semester and Computer Application in fifth and sixth semester as compulsory subjects at graduate level.

However, students of B.C.A. shall be exempted from the study of computer application as compulsory subject.

Minimum Eligibility:

- (i) The candidate must have passed Graduation or equivalent examinations with minimum of 50 per cent marks with Hons. for admission in Postgraduate courses.
- (ii) The candidate must have passed Higher Secondary/Intermediate or equivalent examinations(+2)with minimum of 50 per cent marks for Undergraduate Course. However, the candidates opting for BCA must have Maths and / or Physics in the qualifying examination. Candidates appearing in the Final Year of the qualifying examination may also apply and appear in the Test. However, the candidate must pass the qualifying examination and produce its mark sheet at the time of counselling.
- (iii) For Admission in Under Graduate Courses the candidate must not exceed the age of **22 years as on July 1, 2011**. However, age relaxation will be given to the SC/ST/PH candidates according to the Govt. of India rules.
- (iv) If an applicant is inadvertently allowed to appear at the Entrance Test who otherwise does not fulfill the minimum eligibility requirements at the time of admission, he/she cannot, at a later date, use that as a right to claim their admission in the University.
- (iv) University reserves the right to cancel/refuse admission at any point of time if it is found that:
 - (a) Minimum eligibility requirements are not fulfilled.
 - (b) False documentation has been submitted or, relevant information have been concealed.
 - (c) Any other similar valid reason.

THE APPLICANTS MUST FULLY SATISFY THEMSELVES ABOUT THEIR ELIGIBILITY AS PRESCRIBED ABOVE, BEFORE FILLING IN THE APPLICATION FORM.

How to get and submit Application Form

Application forms can be obtained from the University Office at Amarkantak or Regional Campus, Manipur by hand on the cash payment of Rs. 150/- only (Rs 100/- for ST/SC) or by Submitting a Demand Draft of the Said Amount.

The Application form can be procured by post also for which, the candidate shall have to send a Demand Draft of Rs. 200/- (150/- for ST/SC).

The Demand Draft should be in favour of “**Indira Gandhi National Tribal University**” payable at **State Bank of India, Amarkantak** (Branch Code- 04674).

For getting admission form through post the letter should be sent to The Registrar Indira Gandhi National Tribal University, Amarkantak, Dist – Anuppur, Madhya Pradesh - 484 886, Specifying clearly the Name, Complete address, category & the faculty for which application form is required on a plain paper accompanying the demand draft of Rs. 200/- (Rs.100/- for SC/ST)

The Last date for Submission of duly filled Application forms in University office is 11.07.2011 . After the Last date no application form will be accepted under any corcumstances

Important

- (i) The applicant is advised to write his/her (a) Name, (b) Name of the Course, at the back of the Draft.
- (ii) The applicant is advised to ensure that the Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque is of the required amount and clearly mentions: (a) Date of issue (b) Name & Code No. of issuing branch (c) Amount in words and figures and Signature of the Issuing authority.

Note: Candidate should apply separately if he/she is desirous of applying for more than one course and submit separate Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque for different courses.

For Admission on Under Graduate Courses:

The Admission will be done strictly on the basis of Merit of All India Entrance Test.

For Admission on all Post Graduate Courses (including the courses at Regional Campus, Manipur):

The Admission will be done strictly on the basis of Merit of All India Entrance Test follwed by Group discussion & Personal Interview. The Minimum Qualifying Marks will be atleast 40% in the Entrance Test
